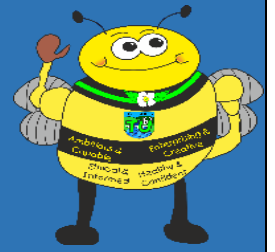

School council elections



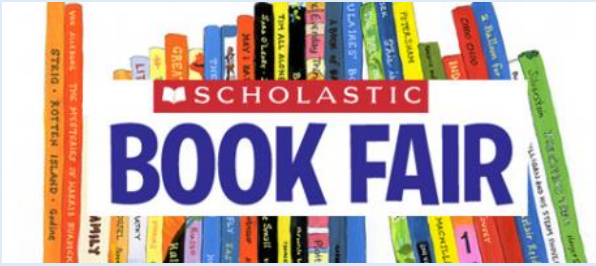
