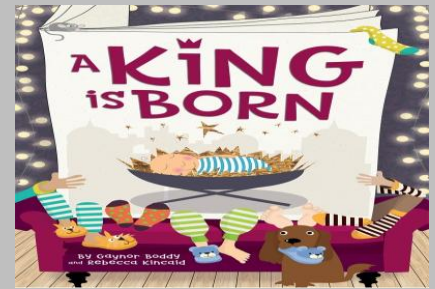
Christmas concerts, trips and parties are coming up and we want the children to enjoy them so please don't return until **48hours** after they have been sick.
