**NO IDLING  
ZONE!**

**Protect our children - turn off your engine**

Unnecessary car idling — when an engine is left running while parked — has a direct impact on the air our children breathe, particularly around school gates. Idling vehicles release harmful pollutants which are linked to asthma, reduced lung development, heart disease and other serious health conditions.

Children are especially vulnerable because their lungs are still developing and they breathe more rapidly than adults. In addition to harming health, idling contributes to climate change through avoidable carbon dioxide emissions and wastes fuel unnecessarily. In Wales, leaving a vehicle engine running unnecessarily on a public road is already an offence, and the Welsh Government is strengthening enforcement powers for local authorities, with fixed penalty notices expected to increase to £50–£100 (rising if unpaid) from 2026.

**Simply switching off your engine while waiting can help protect children’s health, improve local air quality, and support a cleaner, safer school environment for everyone.**
