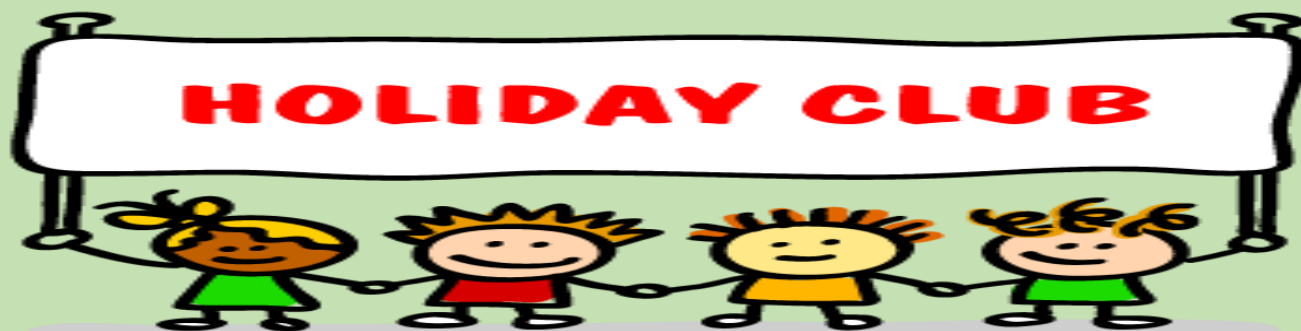
Anything can happen on the roads near and around school so please make sure if you are buying a bike, please buy a helmet too!
